The Heritage Fair

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 5 & TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2018

The 2018 Heritage Fair will take place Monday, November 5 and Tuesday, November 6, 2018. Susan Gearey and Carol Ann Rogers are serving as co-chairs and the event will benefit the 640 Heritage Preservation Foundation's work to preserve 640 Sutter Street and promote the heritage of the women's club movement of the early 20th Century.

Similar to the 2014 event, there will be a Preview Party on the evening of November 5 and a full day of shopping on November 6. Based on feedback from supporters, we have "tweaked" the event format with the following changes:

- The venue will be the Marines' Memorial Club, an historic building, originally a women's club, located across Sutter Street from the Metropolitan Club. This venue offers a number of advantages including easy vendor layout, guest flow, lighting and climate control.
- We will extend the hours available for shopping on November 6 to allow more participation by working women.

We are beginning to reach out to vendors, including some of those who participated in 2014 and new vendors. Do you have a recommendation for a vendor you would love to see next November? We welcome your suggestions.

How do you want to be involved? Please *volunteer now* to participate. There are a variety of opportunities—sponsors, preview party, vendor relations, décor, set-up and day-of operations.

Finally, the Heritage Fair will take place on the large 10th Floor which is often used for events, has easy shopping flow across several rooms and already has many of the tables for vendors that we would otherwise have to rent. Our grateful appreciation to Susan Gearey and Carol Ann Rogers for chairing this significant event!

With the start of the new year, Gee Gee Platt passed the Treasurer's responsibilities to Marie Berggren. Gee Gee ably served the 640 Heritage Preservation Foundation financial interests with an eagle eye for detail and constant diligence as we worked with new accountants and established budgeting policies and practices. 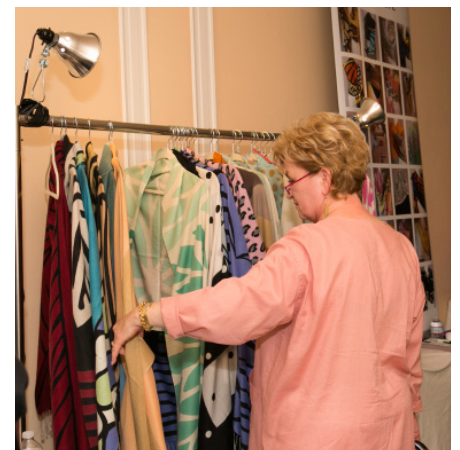
